The former Star Quality Program ended, effective December 31, 2010. With this change, there will no longer be percentage increases on scholarship rates. Providers will also no longer be recognized as a one- or two-star provider under the former program.

Beginning April 1, 2011, incentives and higher reimbursement rates in accordance with the Best Beginnings STARS to Quality Incentives will be released.
